IV INTERNATIONAL ALGIRDAS LOCERIS ACCORDIONIST COMPETITION REGULATIONS

I CHAPTER GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. IV international Algirdas Loceris accordionist competition (further – competition) regulations set the aims, tasks, participants, conditions of organization and execution of the competition.
2. Competition is organized by Birzai Vldas Jakubenas music school (further- school) implementing 2023- 2025 year school's strategic and 2023 year school's activity plans.
3. The competition is dedicated to the 97th anniversary of accordionist Algirdas Loceris.
4. Competition partners: Birzai district Education Help desk, Lithuanian Accordionists Association.

II CHAPTER GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

5. Goal – to develop children's and young people's mastery and creative initiative in accordion music.
6. Objectives:
 - 6.1. to popularize the light music genre and give meaning to the memory of accordionist Algirdas Loceris;
 - 6.2. to promote communication and cooperation of accordion instrument teachers, dissemination of subject and pedagogical experience;
 - 6.3. to organize a competition, promoting the social and cultural expression of students of all ages.

III CHAPTER CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

7. Participants of the competition are young accordionists of Lithuania and foreign art and music schools. Categories of participants and duration of playing time:
 - 7.1. SOLOISTS CATEGORY: A
 - A1 – up to 12 years (born on 2011-05-01 and later) up to 5 min.
 - A2 – up to 16 years (born on 2007-05-01 and later) up to 6 min.
 - A3 – up to 19 years (born on 2004-05-01 and later) up to 8 min.
 - 7.2. ENSEMBLE CATEGORY: B
 - B1 – (the average age of the ensemble participants is up to 15years) up to 5 min.
 - B2 – (the average age of the ensemble participants is up to 17years) up to 7 min.

IV CHAPTER PROCEDURE FOR ORGANIZING THE COMPETITION

10. Participants:

10.1. 2 memorized works are submitted to the competition. One is in the light music genre, the other is optional;

10.2. Results of the competition will be announced on school's website www.muziksmokykla.puslapiai.lt.

10.3. Performers are taking care of travel, catering and accommodation services by themselves.

V CHAPTER WORK EVALUATION CRITERIA

11. Performance of the competition participants will be evaluated by an international evaluation commission formed by the organizers.

11.1. Performers evaluation criteria: musicality, mastery, originality and artistry.

VI CHAPTER AWARDS

12. Performers and teachers who have prepared them will be awarded with diplomas and thanks.

13. Competition participants who will be selected by the Evaluation Commission are granted the right to play at the Birzai Castle Art Gallery in the winners concert which will be dedicated to the 97th anniversary of the birth of Algirdas Loceris.

VII CHAPTER COPYRIGHT AND PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

14. By submitting applications and documents (data) and simultaneously transmitting personal data of the representatives or participants of the organization or any physical persons data (further-data subjects), all participants confirm that they have informed the data subjects that for what purposes and on what grounds their data will be transmitted to school, informed data subjects about their rights and informed that they can find more information about the processing of their data in the privacy policy of school (<https://www.muziksmokykla.puslapiai.lt.asmensduomenuapsauga.lt>). When communicating with the data subject, school considers that he is informed about the processing of his personal data (Article 14 (5) (a) of the BDAR).

15. The personal data of data subject provided by the participants are processed for statistical purposes of the organization, execution (including publication of information about the participants,

selection of winners and public announcement). The controller of personal data is organizer of the competition.

16. The participants agree that their applications and all information about the implemented projects may be used for the purposes of the publicizing the competition.

17. The personal data of participants and data subjects may be disclosed to the members of the evaluation committee. Personal data of participants and data subjects may also be provided to other organizations (Competition partners) that directly perform functions related to the organization and/ or execution of the competition, but only in cases and to the extent that such data is necessary.

18. Participants and data subjects, whose personal data are processed for the purposes of organizing and conducting the competition shall have the right to access their data and learn how they are processed, as well as to request the rectification, destruction or suspension of their personal data processing operations, when the data is processed in violation of these provisions or legal requirements.

20.2. All fees related to money transfers are paid by participants;

20.3. The participation fee is not refunded for those who do not come to the competition

21. The organizers of the competition reserve the right to change and supplement the conditions of the competition.

22. Participation in the competition implies the author’s consent to all terms and conditions of the competition.

23. The organizers of the competition and the teachers whose students will participate in the competition will receive certificates from the Birzai Education support service.
